


## **Agility in Adversity – Series 2**


**#REIMAGINING EDUCATION**

To gauge the problems in the education sector, Alokkit surveyed 291 school leaders from India and launched 'Project Light' to support them with the well-being of students and smooth remote learning. Over the next three months they will:

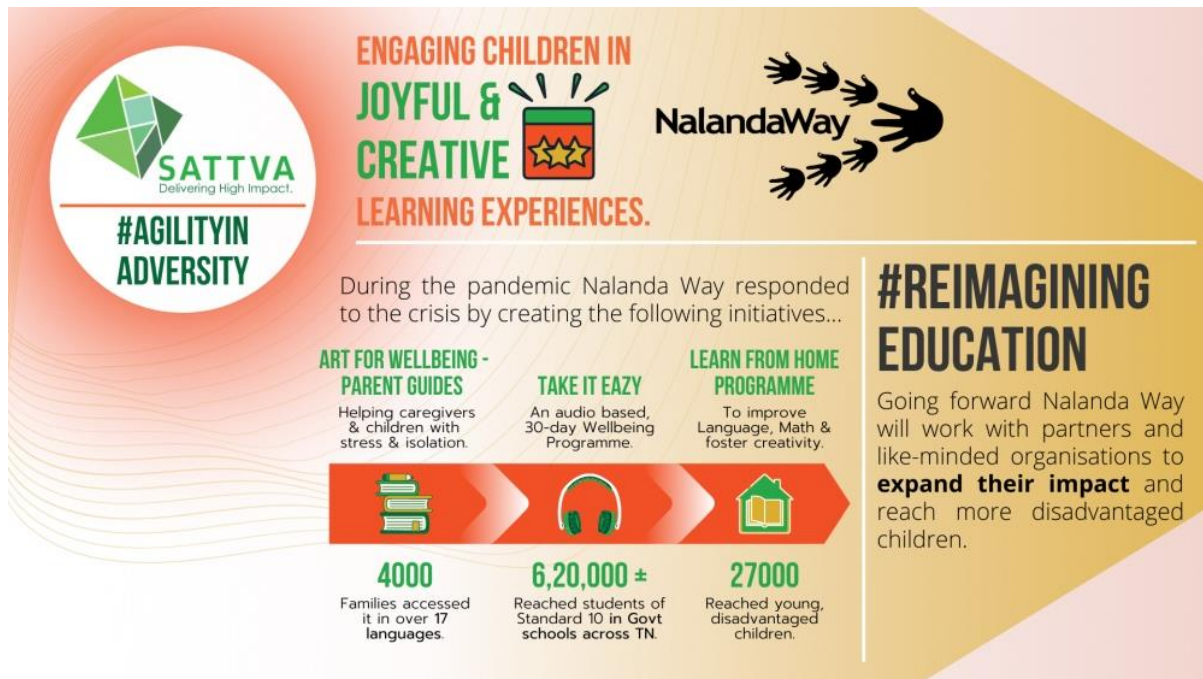

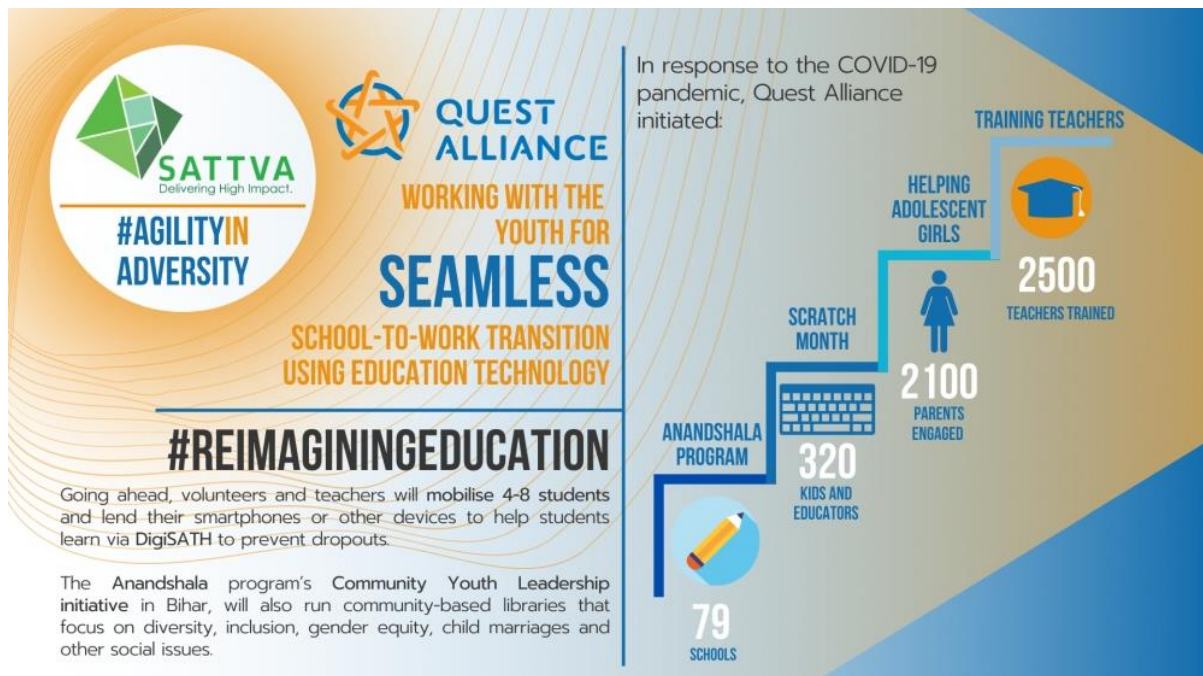
By 2025, Learning Curve intends to enable 3 state governments to adopt and effectively implement social-emotional learning as part of mainstream education practice.

Going forward ChildFund plans to continue with learning support, through a home-based blended approach as well as neighborhood learning sessions until schools reopen. They are simultaneously working with the School Management Committee (SMCs) and education department in supporting the re-opening of the schools which means:



SETTING UP AN EFFECTIVE SYSTEM TO MAP AND TRACK CHILDREN, ENSURING THEY DON'T DROP OUT




PLAN FOR GETTING THE SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE SANITISED AND CAPACITATE TEACHERS.




CONDUCTING SPECIAL BRIDGE SESSIONS FOR ACADEMIC AS WELL AS SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL LEARNING SUPPORT.

In the long term when the schools reopen, ChildFund plans to work closely with the communities to ensure all children go back to the school, minimising the risk of dropouts, while also providing special academic and well-being support for the children.
