


Agility in Adversity




UTTHAN

Work with the government to deliver change at scale through research on rural conditions, recommend appropriate policy changes and support implementation


Build the capacity of public officials through training to improve their understanding of land regulations, and encourage them to prioritize and respect poor rural women and men

Improve land literacy of rural women by creating learning modules tailored to the local context, to help them understand the value of land rights
